A shocking New England Journal of Medicine study revealed that Ella, a form of the "Morning After Pill," can act similarly to the chemical abortion pill (mifepristone), when used at higher doses. What's even more alarming? These pills are being mailed to women before confirming if their pregnancy is implanted in the uterus or a fallopian tube, putting both mother and child at serious risk.

That said, we will continue to work every day to reach every individual who comes through our door with the support they so desperately need. We will **"Light Their Path"** to the only Light that can save their lives. But God....He can do anything!

A Word from Our Executive Director



I've never wanted to be someone who said, "But God, I can't...." Sometimes the clients we see are so lost and I want to say, "But God, we can't reach them!" **And then I remember..."But God...CAN!"** He literally can do anything! He never makes a mistake, is never wasteful, never late. I have a friend who says, "God never gives the wrong assignment to the wrong person." I love that! That faith says if the Lord called them here, then He has a plan and purpose, even if we can't see it. I know this is easier said than done. Our ministry is literally life and death. The lives of the women in crisis that come to us depend on us. The responsibility God has given us is great; we must not take it lightly. **But He can make a way where there is no way!**

Regardless of how you feel about our country's President, this winter **we've witnessed incredible victories in the pro-life movement.**

- Dozens of peaceful pro-lifers were arrested simply for protesting outside abortion facilities. But a few weeks after President Trump's inauguration, he freed 23 of these brave men and women pardoning their sentences.

- We also saw another milestone for life: The House of Representatives passed the Born Alive Act, ensuring that babies who survive failed abortions must receive proper medical care instead of being left to die. That just makes sense and speaks to how far we had fallen as a society.

- One of the most notable changes is the removal of ReproductiveRights.gov, a government-run website, that directed women to abortion providers. That website no longer exists. Women searching for help can find hope and support through OptionLine.org. Option Line connects women to over 3,000 pregnancy help organizations worldwide. This shift ensures women are met with compassion and care when they need it most.

- We're also seeing a change in the visibility of Abortion Pill Reversal (APR). For years, this life-saving option was suppressed in search engines, making it harder for women to learn about reversing the effects of the first abortion pill. Today, APR information is prominently displayed in Google searches, providing women with timely access to the help they need.

- Lastly, President Trump signed an executive order to enforce the Hyde Amendment, effectively eliminating the use of taxpayer dollars to fund or promote elective abortion. His presidential memorandum reinstated a 2017 policy ensuring no taxpayer monies support foreign organizations that perform or actively promote abortion in other nations effectively ending International Planned Parenthood.

These changes mark a significant shift toward truth, transparency, and real choice for women in America and support of the pro-life movement.

While these victories are worth celebrating, the pro-abortion industry is more aggressive than ever.

The success of our banquets cannot be measured simply by the amount of money we raise. Table sponsorships were at an all-time high with 145 tables across the four banquets, resulting in almost 1,200 people hearing our message. Many people volunteered and plan to support us with in-kind donations. Though giving overall was down, donations continue to arrive from those who desire to support our mission of providing light in the darkness.

That is what we are called to do - speak light, life, and truth into others' lives. At the end of the day, they must decide their path; however, we can provide the information they seek to make that decision, the support they need to choose life, and the resources they require to parent/choose parents for their child. The Word says in Job 22:28 "What you decide on will be done, and light will shine on your ways." (NIV)

At our banquets, **Tori Shaw spoke of her life and the result of her abortion decision. She showed us the healing power of Jesus.** Women needing care following an abortion should have easy access to support without fear of judgment or shame. Our hope is that they, too, can find healing.

One in four women have had an abortion, and those statistics don't change through the doors of our churches. We have the ability to guide individuals struggling with the past to healing and restoration. A second round of our after abortion support group begins May 1. (See pg. 3)
